In the workshop we will.....

+Construct a full-scale architectural piece.
+Demonstrate many construction tools and techniques developed during Peters 32 years of building architectural ceramics.

+Hands on demonstrations will be reinforced with slide shows of historic and personal architectural ceramic evolution.

+We will learn how to make a fireplace, an entrance facade, murals, columns and more.

+Peter will show slides of projects in various stages of completion and details of the final installation process.

+ The piece to be made in the workshop will be planed and then constructed with a clay body that allows continuous building and assembling without waiting for the clay to reach the leather hard state.

+After construction, while still wet and up to 5 inches deep, the piece is cut into more manageable sections.

+ The piece is then dried and single fired.
+Construction of the piece takes place over the 5 days.

+Peter King will walk the class through the entire process with demonstrations and slide presentations.

+Something to take home besides a wealth of knowledge?

Assorted press molds and a café table top form will be available for all to use.
